Thank you for entering the 2010 Anglesey Offshore Dinghy Race, and we hope that you and your friends and family have an enjoyable day with us. This information sheet is aimed at making the day easier for you all.

First of all we would like to thank our sponsors, **rainandsun.co.uk**, and **Ynys Môn Tourism and Marketing Dept** also Royal Anglesey Yacht Club for the use of their facilities

The Race; We will be starting close to High water, but will soon have a strong ebb that will take us through Puffin Sound, and all the way to Moelfre. It should be low water when we arrive at Traeth Bychan.

Don't forget the **briefing at 08.30** in the Royal Anglesey YC, and be ready to go on the water straight afterwards. The monohulls start at **10.00 hrs** and the catamaran fleet follows at **10.15 hrs**

The course will be confirmed at the briefing. Read the Sailing Instructions and come to the briefing.

Beumaris: Boats and trailers can be left on Beumaris Green, access through the barrier alongside the slipway adjacent to the RAYC dinghy park over night on Saturday 21st August. Parking charge will apply during the day of the race. Please pay at the cabin situated at the main car park area entrance. Launching is available on the public slipway on the day of the race alongside Beumaris Pier. Royal Anglesey Yacht Club is open daily during Regattas for refreshments and bar.

Traeth Bychan:

To help your friends and family find us here are the directions to Traeth Bychan:

In Beaumaris High Street, face inland in front of the archway alongside the Town Hall. Travel along Church Street opposite between the George & Dragon and The Bold Pubs for about 3 miles till you get to Pentraeth. Turn right at the Panton Arms, following the A5025 towards Amlwch. Ignore signs for Red Wharf Bay, pass through Benllech, and after about 1 mile you will come to a cross roads, where you turn right to Traeth Bychan. If you come to Moelfre roundabout do a 180 and go back to the crossroads and turn left.

At Traeth Bychan, car parking is a premium so our advice is get there early. Park in the car park and take trailers in to the dinghy park. Please try and keep your car away from the bottom of the lane until you are ready to hitch up again.

If you can't get down the lane then we suggest parking in the lay by on the main road, or just in Marianglas village, across the cross roads.

We do request that all competitors co-operate with the Ynys Mon Council Beach Wardens at Traeth Bychan and the RWBSWC Beach Master.

Watching the Race:

The view at Penmon Point, where you can watch the fleet pass through Puffin Sound, is quite spectacular. Drive along the coast road out of Beaumaris, following signs for Penmon Point.

Otherwise, when you have parked up at Traeth Bychan, you can go through the wicket gate at the bottom of the Lane, and watch from the cliff path on the way to Moelfre. You can also go past the Kinmel Arms in Moelfre and round to the rocks between the 2 Lifeboat stations and watch the Moelfre Gate.

Other sailing:

We are also holding free to enter races off Traeth Bychan on Sat 21st starting 11.05hrs and Mon 23rd Aug starting 12.05hrs. which you are very welcome to join. Please indicate on the entry form if you would like to enter these races. Sailing activities at **Traeth Bychan**, will continue throughout the week commencing Monday 23rd August. We can arrange daily or weekly membership of RWBSWC if required.

Social evening

A Hog Roast is planned for the evening of Sat 21st at RWBSWC tickets at £10 / person, bring your own booze. Please confirm numbers on the entry form if you wish to attend.
